QUALIFICATIONS FOR YEAR OF IMPACT

Thank you for your interest in the exciting Year of Impact program for Crotched Mountain School. We are confident this will be a rewarding experience in more ways than one! See below for the minimum qualifications for participation.

Under New Hampshire Childcare Licensing regulations as staff member that is hired in to a child residential setting must be at least 21 years of age, have a high school diploma, high school equivalency certificate, or general equivalency diploma, and meet **ONE** of the following pre-service training and education requirements:

1. An associate's or higher degree with a minimum of 12 credits in the field of human services, or other field related to residential care, awarded by a regionally accredited college or university (examples of human services related courses include Psychology, Sociology, Early Childhood, Communications, Education, etc.)
2. The equivalent of 2 years of full time experience working with children, either as a paid employee or volunteer;
3. Any combination of college credits in human services and experience with children that total 2 years, as follows:
 - Two years of full time college equal 60 credits;
 - Two years of full time employment equals 3000 hours;
 - and one credit equals 50 hours of experience; or
 - Documentation of 7 years of parenting experience
